PVQA Block of the Month—November 2024: Scrappy 9-Patch



You provide all the fabric for this project. It can be as scrappy or uniform as you like. Please choose a black & white fabric for the center square.

Fabric

- Lights—Four 2 ½" squares
- Darks—Four 2 ½" squares
- Black & white—One 2 ½" square

Instructions

Step One—Sew into rows

1. Lay out your nine fabric squares in a pleasing arrangement, with the black & white square in the center and the four light and four dark squares around it.



2. Sew the squares in three rows with right sides together, using a ¼" seam allowance.



3. Press toward the dark fabrics.



Step Two-Assemble the block

- 1. Sew the top row to the middle row, matching up the seams, using a ½" seam allowance. Because the seams are pressed in opposite directions, they should "nest" together.
- 2. Sew the middle row to the bottom row, same as above.
- 3. Press the seams. Your unfinished block should measure 6 ½".

This is a "makeup" block, so you can make as many of these as you like to build up your BOM credits.
