

Community Quilt Display

Starting in 2009, a display of community quilts has been placed in the Arts Building during the Quilt Show. The reason for this display is to show all the Quilt Show guests some of the volume and scope of work that is done by the guild for members of our communities.

The equipment used is: 4-8' tables, 2 wooden lattice, plus some informative signage, rope, uprights and an easel.

The groups that contribute quilts are:

All Star Quilts for Kids

Apple Piecers

Quilters for Hospice

Veterans Quilts—headed up by Sandy Helin.

Generally, representatives from All Stars, Apple Piecers and Quilters for Hospice set up the display. The area is usually manned by Cathie Colson for much of the show.

The outreach groups are asked to stockpile their quilts so there would be a large showing of quilts for the Quilt Show.

The rope and uprights are used as a barrier so the quilts would not be handled by the Quilt Show guests.
