

Viewer's Choice Job Description

The Viewer's Choice Committee is responsible for providing ballots, pencils, ballot box and ribbons.

Ballots are counted and ribbons are awarded. Ribbons may be awarded for Saturday voting and Sunday voting or for the duration of the show.

Ribbons may be purchased or handmade.

In addition, this committee invites three to five community judges who in some way represent the quilt show theme. Judges are given badges to attend the preview party. We ask these judges to choose a favorite quilt, the best quilt in their opinion, or the quilt that best represents the show theme. Ribbons should indicate on the back which judge chose that quilt. A sign indicating who chose that quilt, and the name and association is displayed near the ribbon. Committee members escort the judges to the preview party.

Results are announced at the March meeting, including the Saturday results (if awarded), though the ribbons have already been given.
