

White Gloves

Supervise all the White Glove volunteers during the Quilt Show. White glove volunteers assist quilt show attendees if they would like to look at the backs of quilts. Quilt Show attendees are NOT allowed to touch the quilts due to oils/dirt on hands. White glove volunteers “patrol” an area to keep attendees from touching or handling items. White Glove volunteers can answer questions about quilting (if they are comfortable with that) but it is NOT a requirement. White gloves are provided by the guild.

May be asked to lead small groups around Quilt Show (Girl Scouts, Home Economic classes, etc.) and explain show exhibits and/or special techniques.
