- Sewing machine capable of free motion stitching
- Standard sewing/quilting supplies (thread, sewing machine needles, small cutting board (18x24 is the best size but smaller is OK if you are working small), etc.)
- Fabric scraps
 - *“Bring Lots of scraps- I’m talking about the scraps you get when fussy cutting, but any will do. You may wish to sort first and bring only scraps that work well with each other and contain a range of light to dark value. It also helps if people do not feel too possessive about their scraps and are willing to share. Sometimes the ideal piece or color is in someone else’s pile.”*
- Elmer’s purple glue stick
- Piece of batting at least 15”x20” but smaller is OK if you like to work small. Also some random width strips in case you want to extend your piece.
- Sharp scissors for fussy cutting
- Several pieces of mat board (cardboard from calendars is a good substitute); random sizes from 4” x 6” to 8 ½”x11”) are best.
- 8”x11.5” white paper (for the gluing process)
- LOTS of straight pins
- Fabric for the back of your piece. Bring at least a yard of something that would go with most/any of the scraps you bring.
