

JULY 2020 BLOCK OF THE MONTH - DOG DAYS OF SUMMER

Thanks for participating in BOM! This is easy. I was thinking of all the pets we love who are part of our family. I thought we could honor them with these sweet dog faces.

Before you begin, read all instructions here and BOM instructions on the website.

You will be given 1 fussy cut dog, a black strip and 2 accent strips. Your challenge is to find a pattern, any pattern that you like, for a 13" block. One source I use a lot is Quilt Blocks Galore online.

Find the tab, "Blocks by Size", 13" to 15" and several patterns will come up. Or, you can find another pattern that you like from other sources.

Use the black strip to frame your dog. Use other fabrics in your block. If you need more fabric, call or email me and I will forward that to you. You may use fabric from your stash, just keep to the color way with solids and/or small prints as in the pictures of samples above. The idea is to have a sampler quilt. You may also duplicate my samples, if you like.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Please email or call me so I can put you on the signup list.
2. If you choose to print these instructions from the website, go ahead, but PLEASE let me know so I don't mail duplicates to you.
3. Complete the information on the next page and return with the completed block so I can give you credit and you can be in the August drawing.
4. **Do not** mail the instructions back to me. They are yours to keep.
