

Block of the month- February 2021

Valentine Heart Candy Quilt



FABRIC:

One 10" square, background-Enclosed

One 6" fusible square-Enclosed

One paper Valentine heart shape-Enclosed.

You provide one 6" pastel cotton square in lavender, yellow, pink, or green, etc. (See Candy Heart Photo, above and on page 2.)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Place 6" fusible square (rough side) onto WRONG side of your 6" pastel square.
2. Trim any excess fusible so it matches the 6" fabric square.
3. Fold the 10" background square into 4ths and press. Where the lines meet is the center of the 10" square.
4. Cut out paper heart pattern. Pin paper heart pattern to the fused (white) side of the 6" square.
5. Draw around the heart pattern. Cut out the heart on the drawn lines.
6. Center the 6" fabric square (right side facing you) onto the 10" printed fabric square (right side facing you).
7. Pin the heart to the 10" square. Practice a small, close, zig zag stitch on waste fabric. With the zig zag or decorative stitch, stitch the fabric valentine to the 10" printed square. Stitch once again. With a permanent blue or dark pink fabric pen, write a Valentine Candy phrase on your pastel heart. Use one from the Candy Heart photo or make up your own (GP only).
