

OCTOBER BLOCK OF THE MONTH – TABLE RUNNER



Crisp autumn days are here. Let's make some placemats for our Thanksgiving tables or as a hostess gift. We will use fall colors, the colors of falling leaves. This is a "make-up" block, which means you can make 1 to 4 placemat **tops** or 1 to 4 **complete** placements. You will be given **3** credits for each placemat top. If you layer, quilt and bind the placemat, you will be given **6** credits for each. If we get enough placemats, there will be several winners of sets of 2 for your TG dinner. This would also make a great hostess gift.

INSTRUCTIONS:

All fabrics are provided; 14 five-inch Kaffe squares and 18 five-inch white on white squares. Seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Alternate the white and the Kaffe prints. Sew squares together and the rows vertically using the diagram on page 2 and the photo above.

Please return your completed top or table runner and the completed drawing slip to me in time for our next meeting on November 8th. My address, email and telephone # are on the roster. You can also email me through the PVQA website at pvqa.org look under Block of the Month tab.

Line up your squares **vertically** using the photo above and the diagram on Pg. 2 Alternate light (white on white) with dark (Kaffe print). Sew them together and press seams toward the Kaffe print.

Row 1 =2 squares

Row 4 =5 squares

Row 7 =4 squares

Row 2 =4 squares

Row 5 =5 squares

Row 8 =2 squares

Row 3 =5 squares

Row 6 =5 squares
